MASS TRANSIT ROUTES ON VIENNA'S RINGSTRASSE BOULEVARD

From the city center direct to the Hundertwasserhaus and the Prater park

Tram 1 is of particular interest to visitors to Vienna. Now all the sights along the Ringstrasse – including the Burgtheater, City Hall, the Parliament building, the Museum of Fine Arts, the Natural History Museum, the Hofburg Palace, and the State Opera House – are linked with the Prater park and Hundertwasserhaus on a single line.

Tram 2 follows the Ringstrasse from the Parliament building, passing the Museum of Fine Arts, the Natural History Museum, the Hofburg Palace, and the State Opera House. It then follows the edge of the Stadtpark, with stops at the Museum of Applied Arts (MAK) and the Urania on the way to Schwedenplatz.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Underground, Tram & Bus

The best ticket for your customers to use on public transportation is the Vienna Card (see page 26). Alternatively, the following tickets are available:

- ☑ 24-hour network pass costing € 5.70
- ☑ 48-hour network pass costing € 10
- ☑ 72-hour network pass costing € 13.60
- ☑ 8-day network ticket costing € 28.80 (can also be used by several people traveling together, simply validate one strip per person and calendar day).
- ☑ Weekly network pass Mon 09:00–Mon 09:00 costing € 14
- ☑ Single tickets costing € 1.80 (advance purchase) – may be obtained individually at the vending machines in underground stations, and at all other sales outlets as a strip of 4 tickets.
- ☑ Children's tickets for 2 trips costing € 1.80

Children up to the age of 6 always travel free. Children aged up to 15 travel free on Sundays and public holidays as well as during Vienna school vacations (photo ID required).

Tickets are available from tobacconists, Wiener Linien sales counters and the vending machines at underground stations.

Single-trip tickets costing € 2.20 can also be purchased on board trams and buses. They are valid for one-way travel on underground, tram and bus services through to the destination (including changes).

PARKING IN VIENNA

The historic center of Vienna and its immediately surrounding districts (1010–1090, 1200 and parts of 1150) are short-term pay parking zones. Parking here requires a valid parking permit ("Parkschein") placed behind the windshield from the first minute on. The signs indicating the short stay parking zones are posted only as you enter these districts. In shopping streets, days of validity and maximum lengths of stay may vary.

FROM/TO VIENNA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (VIE)

CAT

The CAT (City Airport Train) is the fastest direct connection between Vienna International Airport and the city center with city check-in facilities at Wien-Mitte. You can check in and obtain your boarding card at the Wien-Mitte terminal for Star Alliance, Air Berlin, NIKI and Transaero flights (further details of the CAT service and a full list of airlines with city check-in facilities can be found at www.cityairporttrain.com). Check-in is possible from 24 hours up to 75 minutes prior to departure.

City Air Terminal: corner of Invalidenstrasse/Marxergasse, 15 minutes' walk from Stephansplatz.

Traveling time: 16 minutes non-stop

Departures: every half hour

Price (ticket vending machine): € 10 single, € 18 return

Children aged up to 5 years free and 1 child (aged 6–14) accompanied by an adult free. Tickets can be booked online on the CAT website www.cityairporttrain.com (reduction € 1), or purchased from ticket vending machines or the conductors on the train (surcharge € 1).

By Bus

From Westbahnhof station ▶ Meidling station ▶ City Center (Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz) ▶ Vienna International Airport
Service runs daily from 05:00–00:20 every 20/30 minutes, duration of trip approx. 20 minutes

From Vienna International Centre ▶ Vienna International Airport
Service runs daily from 06:00–20:10 at hourly intervals, duration of trip approx. 20 minutes

One way ticket: € 6

Return ticket: € 11

Reduced ticket for Vienna Card holders: € 5

(Includes 3 pieces of luggage)

The bus stop at Vienna International Airport is located directly in front of the arrivals and departures halls.

By Rail

Trains on the S7 line run at 30-minute intervals, reaching the Airport in 32 minutes. They stop at all stations between Wien-Mitte and the Airport.

Tickets: 1 central zone (€ 1.80) + 1 outer zone (€ 1.80) = € 3.60 single fare. Anyone already holding a ticket for the central zone (city area) or a Vienna Card only has to buy a ticket for 1 outer zone (€ 1.80).

By Taxi

Approximate price: € 30

Approximate duration: 30–45 minutes

Radio taxis are entitled to ask for an additional return fee of € 10 on trips to the airport.

FROM/TO RAIL STATIONS

Wien Meidling serves as the terminus while Südbahnhof is closed for refurbishment. Trains on the southern line either stop at Meidling or connect to the S-Bahn network. Eastern line long-distance routes formerly departing Südbahnhof now leave from Wien Meidling or Westbahnhof.
